In the article of the above title in Acarologia 7: 30-42, the gnathosoma of the male (Fig. 1 C, page 32) is shown as symmetrical, this is in error as the gnathosoma is asymmetrical in the anterior portion of the hypostomal region in the male. The right side should contain two processes medial of the corniculi, one which extends to the end of the palpal femur, the other being a knoblike process at the base of the first. The left side also has a knoblike process at the base of the hypostomal extension.
